- Household hazardous materials (paint, pesticides, cleaning supplies, motor oil, etc.)
- Medications (non-scheduled/non-controlled drugs only)

What NOT to bring

- Bulky household items (mattress, furniture, etc.)
- Construction and demolition waste (drywall, concrete, wood, bricks, etc.)
- Household garbage
